OCTC FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

Ray and Alice Addington Family Scholarship

Established by Dr. Jacqueline Addington

MONETARY AWARD: full or partial tuition

GUIDELINES: Must be enrolled in a Certificate, Diploma or Associate Degree program; Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA required.

Morton J. Holbrook, Jr. Memorial Scholarship

Established, in memoriam, by the Holbrook family & friends

MONETARY AWARD: full or partial tuition

GUIDELINES: Must be enrolled in a Certificate, Diploma or Associate Degree program; Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA required.

Dr. Bruce Beck Memorial Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: per funds available

GUIDELINES: Must be an Ohio County resident; enrolled full-time (12 credit hours or more); majoring in an Associate Degree program; Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA required.

OCTC Community Healthcare Scholarship

Established by Ms. Jean Wells

MONETARY AWARD: full or partial tuition

GUIDELINES: Students seeking to provide healthcare in the Owensboro area, with a preference for students who plan to work with the aging population. Must be enrolled in a Certificate, Diploma or Associate Degree program; majoring in Certified Nurse Aide, Licensed Practical Nurse or Registered Nurse; Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA required; enrolled in six (6) credit hours or more.

Ernest A Weill, III Memorial Scholarship

Established, in memoriam, by the Weill Family and friends

MONETARY AWARD: per funds available

GUIDELINES: Must be a KY resident, with first priority to Daviess County residents; majoring in Engineering and/or Architecture; Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA; may be used for tuition, fees or books.

OCTC Foundation Scholarship—NEW STUDENT

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: **New** OCTC students enrolling within three (3) years of high school completion; must file FAFSA; have a 3.0 GPA; ACT of 19 or COMPASS equivalent; must reapply each academic year.

OCTC Foundation Scholarship-RETURNING STUDENT

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: **Returning** OCTC students; must file FAFSA; have a 2.5 GPA first semester, 3.0 GPA thereafter; must reapply each academic year.

OCTC ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Lester E. Yeager Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: Applicants must be from Daviess County and/or surrounding areas.

Ray Gillaspie Scholarship—High School Senior

MONETARY AWARD: up to \$1,500 per year*

GUIDELINES: Must have 2.0 high school GPA; provide four (4) letters of reference (non-relative, two must be from instructors, two from non-school personnel); Biographical Statement; **Ohio County** resident; complete Admissions file; must be degree-seeking in a technical degree. (*Separate Application Required*)

Ray Gillaspie Scholarship—Adult Students

MONETARY AWARD: up to \$1,500 per year*

GUIDELINES: Must have 2.0 GPA; provide four (4) letters of reference (non-relative, two must be from instructors, two from non-school personnel); Biographical Statement; **Ohio County** resident; complete Admissions file; must be degree-seeking in a technical degree. (*Separate Application Required*)

M. H. Ford Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: full tuition for 2 years

GUIDELINES: Priority to Fine Arts student

KCTCS SCHOLARSHIPS

The Kentucky Colonels Better Life Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: \$2,500 per year

GUIDELINES: Must be full-time student pursuing a KCTCS Associate degree; Kentucky resident; single working parent with one or more children under the age of 12; demonstrate financial need.

SYSTEMS OFFICE SCHOLARSHIPS

Commonwealth Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: Kentucky resident; students in top 25% of high school class (including past graduates); enrolled in six (6) credit hours or more. Scholarship is renewable for second year by completing a scholarship application and having successfully completed 24 credit hours at a KCTCS institution and maintained a GPA of 3.0.

President's Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: Must file a FAFSA; have a 3.0 GPA; ACT of 19 or COMPASS equivalent. **Returning students must maintain a 3.0 GPA.**

John T. Smith Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: Six (6) credit hours or more; African-American; Kentucky resident; 2.5 GPA.

EXTERNAL SCHOLARSHIPS

E. B. Burgess Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to full tuition*

GUIDELINES: Must be a member of the Green River Federal Credit Union and/or immediate family member.

Owensboro Chapter of the American Association for Women in Community Colleges Scholarship (AAWCC)

MONETARY AWARD: per funds available

GUIDELINES: Must be a female with a minimum GPA of 2.5 for a continuing student or a minimum ACT composite score of 19 or COMPASS minimum Reading score of 84 **and** COMPASS minimum English score of 65 for a high school student is required. *Preference will be given to those who demonstrate financial need.*

N.O. Kimbler Scholarship

MONETARY AWARD: up to \$1,100 per year

GUIDELINES: Education major
